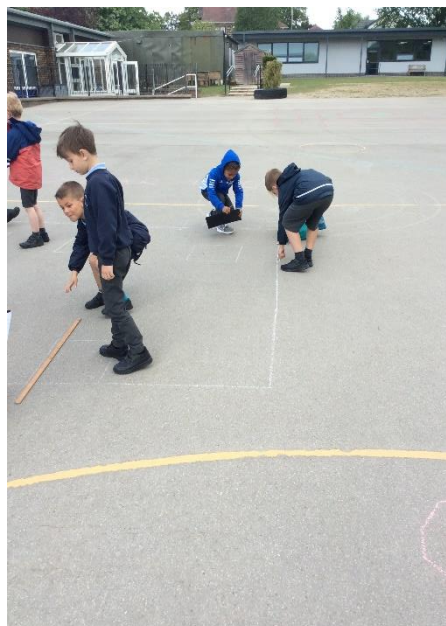


For our outdoor art lesson this week in Year 1, we used natural resources we found outside to create our own self-portraits with crazy hair!
