


ONE LIFE

ATTENDANCE

We are in process of reviewing our attendance procedures and once we have finalised these, they will be available on the website for you to look at. However, just as a reminder:

We open our gates and doors at **8.40am** to allow the children plenty of time to get into their classroom by the required time of **8.50am**.

By law, schools must keep an attendance register which must be taken at the start of the first session (morning) and again during the second session (afternoon). The register marks whether the pupil is present, attending an approved off-site educational activity, absent or unable to attend due to exceptional circumstances. Department for Education Attendance codes are used.

- School's official starting time is **8.50am**. Staff take the register in the classroom by **9.00am**. This is the cut-off point for staff in classrooms taking registers.
- Any child arriving after class doors are shut and via the front door will be registered by the office staff.

Please remember how important it is that children are punctual and arrive prepared for the day's learning. This is to support them both academically and with their mental wellbeing.

Attendance 2 September 2025 to 4 September 2025: 98.8%

Remember: The gates open at 8.40pm and school starts promptly at 8.50am.

Today's attendance is 99.1%. This is fabulous, let's keeping it going.



The Sibling Group was founded by our CEO Grace. Grace who was born in Harrogatis, North Yorkshire had two siblings an elder sister and younger brother Oscar. Oscar was diagnosed with severe learning disabilities and Autiana the age of 3. At this time like many others, Grace's family were unsure what this meant for their future. Grace and her elder sister struggled with the many challengas of having a sibling with SEN and felt isolated and misunderstood by the work or around them. They felt lackly to have wach other to talk to but wished they could have known other in similar postions as then, as they didn't want to burden their parents with their concerns and feelings surrounding their brother's needs. Grace and her sister feel that siblings of SEN children are often overlooked or discredited as they were not the ones with the needs so therefore are expected to be line. Often children take on the worries or concerns surrounding the welfare of their SEN slibing which can lead to their own mental health issues.

Grace went on to gain a first degree in Special Education and a distinction in her PBCE & qualified teaching status and worked as a SEM teacher in London. She is currently studying her masters in Autism and Inclusion. Whilst writing her dissertation she based it on the affect a child with special needs has on their sibling, to which she found herself interviewing her sister end revisiting their shared experience growing up with a sibling with special needs and the emotionel effects this had an them.

Reminding her of their lack of support.
