Please note that you only need to complete the form if your child **is not attending** the evening performance. We would be grateful if you could do this before Friday 21st November so teachers are able to organise speaking parts.

There will be a morning rehearsal at 9:15am (children, teachers and parents helpers) and a full evening performance starting at 6.30pm, which is expected to finish by 7.30pm. (Please can all children start arriving at 6.15pm).

Tickets are **not** required for the evening concert, but due to the limited seating available in St Mark's Church, **we ask that no more than two people per child attend.** There is no charge, however, cash donations will be collected with all proceeds being given to the church. It would be preferable if you did not bring pre-schoolers in the evening as they may distract our children from their performance. Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.

On the morning of Monday 15th December, we will need the support of enough parents to walk the children safely to and from St Mark's Church. If you are free to help please DoJo your class teacher by Monday 1st December. We will be leaving school at 9.15am and leaving St Mark's at around 11.30 - 11.45am. Anyone helping us to accompany the children are welcome to watch the morning rehearsal, however please be mindful of the fact that this will be a stop-start rehearsal.

The Christmas concert is always a fantastic event at the end of our Autumn term and we hope that you will be able to join us.
