A huge thank you to Santa who took time out of his busy schedule and located himself in our Music Room – there were lots of smiling children exiting the building with presents in tow! Lots of 'making' took place and several children showed me the snow globes, wreaths and Christmas decorations they had made. We also had lots of children who had made items at home, selling them at the Christmas Fair, which was fabulous. This complemented the work we do as a Centre of Excellence for Finance and built on the financial education work we do in school. Mrs Nimick who leads Financial Education in school was very impressed, as was I.

On Monday, Jon Ireland from Harrogate Harriers led an assembly to encourage the children to join and have a go at track and field events such as: javelin, shot put, sprinting, cross country, long jump, high jump, hurdles etc. Jon attended our Rossett Acre Park Run Takeover, last half term, and was very impressed with the running/sprinting of the children involved.

Jon spoke to the children about joining Harrogate Harriers and/or the Young Athletes Club that runs at Rossett School. A few of our children already attend some of these sessions and when I asked the children who was interested, about 25% of the children raised their hands, which was great.

I'm pleased to say that we raised £181.87 for Children in Need. This is hopefully in addition to donations that parents made directly online to the charity. Well done everyone.

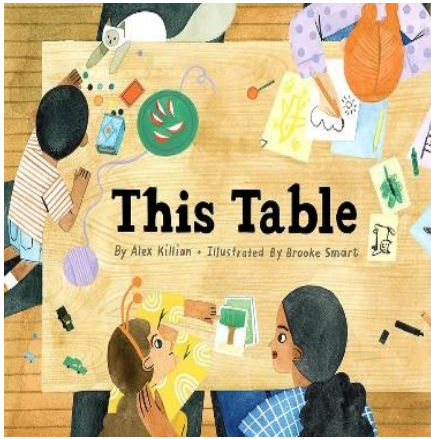

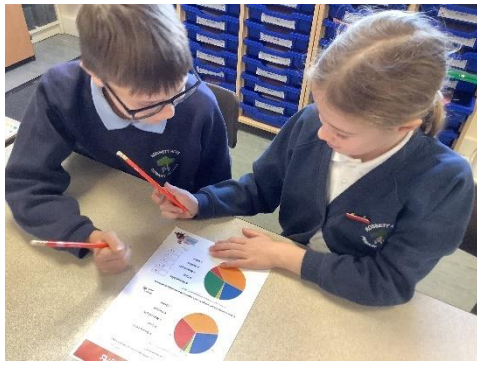

ENERGY HEROES

On Wednesday morning, Sue Abbott from the charity Energy Heroes, visited for an assembly on climate change and what we can do to make a difference to our energy consumption at home and in school. Following the assembly, Year 5 took part in a workshop. They looked at pie charts of data comparing the sources of electricity generation since 2007. They learnt about the importance of increasing the use of renewables and reducing the amount of fossil fuels. The boys and girls used lots of mathematical knowledge to support their understanding of this data: from reading pie charts accurately, to working out percentages. Everyone was very excited to receive a new Energy Heroes pencil and take away task looking at the use of energy in their own homes. Energy Heroes will be coming back to do an energy audit of the school and work with our Eco Committee.





MISS DODGSON'S CLASS ROCK

Miss Dodgson's class shone brightly in the recent **TTRS England Rocks competition**, showing an incredible mix of determination, teamwork, and sheer multiplication mastery. Throughout the event, the children demonstrated fantastic focus and enthusiasm, logging on each day with excitement and giving their very best. Their impressive scores and excellent progress were a testament not only to their hard work but the competitiveness of the children and Miss Dodgson.

The class came 29th out of the 28,456 schools which is a phenomenal achievement. Miss Thornton-Jones, the Red Kite Primary Director, was in assembly on Friday and she could not believe how super the class had been.

Chester came 29th out of the whole of the country, being the highest scorer for Rossett Acre. Lennon was 30th and Sonny was 32nd. This is amazing to say that nearly 400,000 students took part! Everyone in the class played their part in the success - never have brains and fingers moved so quickly! Hard work and effort over the years at practising on TTRS has really paid off. Well done, Miss Dodgson's class!

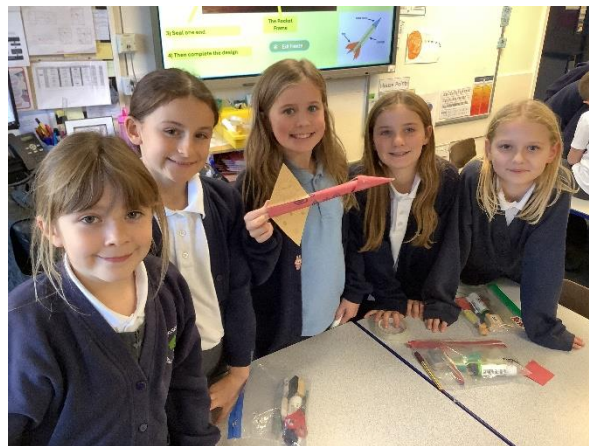

TRAINING SESSIONS
