Dear Parents and Carers

New Termly Reports for children in Years 1-6

You may remember that we sent a letter out on 24 June 2025 regarding termly reports. From this term, all children in Years 1-6 will now receive a termly report in order for you to be more informed about how your child is doing at school. In Autumn and Spring Terms, the reports will consist of grades for Reading, Writing, Maths and Attitude and Behaviour. The Summer term report will be the same as last year, with grades for each subject as well as Teacher comments.

The grades take the format of a colour coding system and is a Teacher Assessment of where your child is judged to be at this stage of the year. All Trust schools have the same format and colour coding system which is explained below.

Understanding the colour codes in the new termly reports:

- **Red+** – Children with significant barriers to learning who may only make small steps of progress.
- **Red** – Children who regularly need extra adult support or interventions in order to make progress.
- **Amber** – Children who are being monitored and given additional support or interventions to help secure progress. Without this support, they are unlikely to move to Green.
- **Green** – Children who access the taught curriculum with quality-first teaching and only minimal extra support. They may need occasional short-term interventions to maintain progress.
- **Green+** – Children who are confidently working well above the expected level and require little or no additional support.

We hope you will find these reports informative. Any queries regarding the attainment/progress should be directed in the first instance to your child's teacher.
