



Schools Photo Competition



As part of Great Big Green Week 2026, we are running a Schools Photo Competition and would like to invite you and your pupils to enter.

For the competition: Photos can be of any activity, event or piece of work which shows support for action to tackle climate change, protect the planet and create a greener, fairer future.

Possible activities could involve reusing or swapping items, for example:

- Collecting good quality clothing for a homeless charity.
- Running a book/toy swap or second hand book/ toy sale.
- Creating something new from reused or waste items, such as plastic bags, plastic bottles, drinks cans, scraps of material, bottle tops, sweet wrappers, cardboard etc. Pupils could make items individually or as part of a group. Items could include, for example: an outfit, a tote bag, a quilt, a collage, a mosaic, a model or sculpture, or any other piece of art work. Pupils might want to incorporate an environmental message or alert people to a particular environmental issue, such as single use plastic.

Take photos of your event or activity and we will display them at a **special Great Big Green Week event on 11th June at Creative Harrogate. *Any models / artwork children make can also be displayed at the event on 11th June with children, parents and staff all welcome to come along for the presentation of Fairtrade prizes on the night for the best ideas and photos.***
