COLOUR RUN – 16TH JULY 2026

The PTA are delighted to invite your child to take part in our **Rossett Acre Colour Run on Thursday 16th July** which is set to be a fun-filled afternoon for everyone.

What's happening?

After lunch, children will take part in a colourful run around the school grounds, passing through different "colour stations" where they'll be gently covered in bright powder. It's a great mix of fun, energy and a little bit of mess!

The Richmond Avenue gate will be open for parents to come and watch and cheer the children on, although children will remain in their class groups on the playground. Please note that this will be the only access to the school to see the Colour Run. Please do not come to the office to gain access. Children who are not taking part will be able to sit with their classes.

What your child will need

- Old clothes (white t-shirts work particularly well)
- Trainers
- Sunglasses – these will be provided with every entry to ensure that children have a pair

Please note: the coloured powder is made from corn starch and food-grade colouring and is safe to use, although it can be messy.

How to take part

You can choose one of the following options which are available to purchase on School Shop on Arbor:

- **£5** – includes colour powder and sunglasses
- **£8** – includes powder, sunglasses and a white t-shirt

Children can only take part if they have completed the Microsoft Form below, which includes consent, key information and (if needed) t-shirt size. **One form will have to be filled in per child. Please do not try to fill one in for multiple children as we will not be able to accept it.**

There will also be an opportunity for children to raise sponsorship from family and friends – more details will follow shortly.


End of the day
