## YEAR 5 SCIENCE VISIT

On Tuesday, the Year 5s visited the Harrogate Grammar Science department for a morning of workshops with the teachers there. Our first session was using microscopes with Dr Stamford: we were looking for *Daphnia* (hopping water fleas) in a sample of water and tried hard to count heart beats. We could see them breathing and some groups even thought they saw tiny circles, which were embryos. In the second session (with Mr Rush) we made pop rockets using vinegar and vitamin tablets. Everyone explored how to make their own rockets, which created lots of excitement!
