Everyone has coped amazingly this week, and I would like to thank everyone for their support. The children have continued with their learning and understood the changes of routine. I am very proud of them.

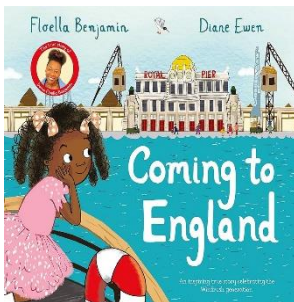
## MONDAY ASSEMBLY
