Good afternoon

Nell Bank – Final Arrangements

We are looking forward to the upcoming trip. The weather is looking good so children DO NOT need to bring wellies or boots but should definitely have named sun cream (children cannot use each others), a named sun hat and also you may want your child to have some bug spray which they can put on after their sun cream.

Here are the final arrangement details for next week together with some reminders about what to bring/not bring to Nell Bank.

Wednesday morning departure

Children need to come to school as normal in non-uniform. If it is raining, please bring the cases to the Sports Hall. If it is dry, then bags/cases should be brought to the top playground – just in front of the Year 6 grassed area.

The children will be able to say goodbye to you and then enter their classroom for registration at normal time. They should bring their backpacks and water bottles into the classroom. Please ensure your child has a coat even if the weather is forecast to be good.

They do not need lunch as it is provided by the kitchen for all children.

The children will not be leaving until after 11am as we cannot arrive at Nell Bank before 12pm.

Medication

If your child has any medication (all medication should be handed to staff – e.g. Piriton, paracetamol etc as well as prescribed medication), it should be signed in with Miss Blyde – who will be in the Sports Hall on Wednesday morning. Children must NOT have their own medication – including travel sickness tablets, magnesium tablet, vitamins etc. If your child is at Fun Club, please hand over the medication to Fun Club with clear directions attached to the medication. Please check the medication **IS IN DATE** – otherwise we cannot accept it.

Please ensure all medication is collected - particularly inhalers and other essential medication you may need at home over the weekend.



Friday afternoon return

We will leave the centre about 11.30am. We should arrive back at school at approximately 12.15pm-12.30pm. The children will then have lunch and take part in follow up reflection activities in the afternoon in their classes.

Regarding cases, the children will put their cases in the Sports Hall if wet, but if it is dry:

- Mrs Aslam/Mrs Haslam's class cases will be outside their classroom on the grass.
- Mrs Ingle/Mrs Sims' class cases will be in the Quiet Area.

A few reminders:

- No lunches are needed. They are all provided including the day of departure.
- Children need to bring a pillow, a bottom sheet and thin sleeping bag and/or sheet to sleep under – we anticipate that the dorms will be warm since the weather is good.
- Please use the smallest bag possible. A cabin-sized hand luggage should be sufficient. There is not room if everyone brings a huge suitcase! If children do have a case larger than hand luggage – please don't fill it – just because there is room!
- Please stick closely to the kit list. They do not need Oodies/dressing gowns etc. – these just add to the amount of things brought and increase the case size, and mess in the dorms!
- The children will need a coat.
- Children should not bring extra food or sweets etc. Any food sent in will be confiscated and returned to you at the end of the trip. We do monitor what children are eating and have found in previous years we have had concerns when children have not eaten meals, only to find they have eaten a large amount of food from their suitcase. We also need to be mindful of allergies.
- Children should not bring face masks/nail sets or "Pamper Party" things. It is not a sleepover! They can bring an eye mask, however, as this may help them to sleep.
- Children should bring a book to read.
- They should not bring a torch, or any other electronic devices/smart watches.
- No money is needed.
- Please don't send any "treats" for your child – it really isn't fair on the other children.
