P4C

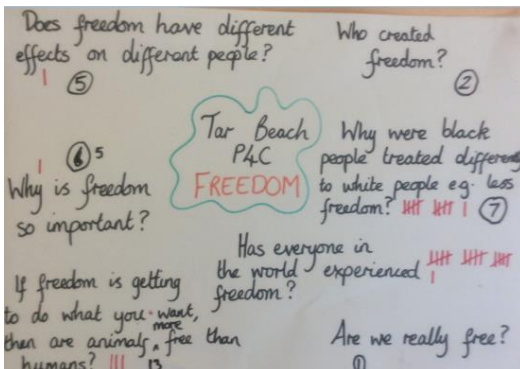
