PE and Sport Premium

Year 6 Swimming – Academic Year 2022 - 2023

Sports Premium Funding was used to provide 'Top-Up' swimming lessons for children within the Year 6 cohort who could not swim 25 metres by the end of Year 5. The children identified were invited to attend weekly lessons at the Hydro/Starbeck Pool during the Summer term.
