Year 4 Summer Term

Here are your homework choices for our 'Environmental Explorers' theme. Try to complete at least one activity from the boxes below each half term. Your work should be beautifully presented and in your own words. There is the option to do something different to the ideas listed, as long as it links to our theme. Check with your teacher to see if your idea is suitable.

Use Google Earth to locate your house. Draw a map of the streets and roads around your house. Can you use any map symbols?

Find out about an environmental activist such as Greta Thunberg. What have they done to make a difference?

There are many species which are threatened with extinction. Find out about an endangered species such as the sea turtle, orangutang or tiger. Try to find out the threats they face as well as what can be done to help them. Create a poster to present your findings.

RUBBISH ART - use items which would otherwise be thrown away (eg lolly sticks, bottle tops, boxes, etc) to create your own artwork.

Find out about Andy Goldsworthy and create a fact file to show what you have learned.

Create your own artwork or sculpture based on ideas from Andy Goldsworthy's work.

RECYCLE - Find out about what happens when we recycle things. What can we recycle and what happens when we send something to be recycled?

REUSE - Choose an item which is going to be thrown away and try to find a way to reuse it. Can you give it a new purpose? For example, you could make a bag from an old piece of clothing or a plant pot from an old can.
